Work: The city of Seogwipo is located along a volcanic coastline which forms part of the Biosphere Reserve. Due to warm water temperatures, the area is home to a year-round sub-tropical fish population. It is a critical habitat for marine fauna and flora, including various rare corals. People residing in the Biosphere Reserve make their living from tourism, cattle ranching, and agriculture. Sustainable development is one of the main challenges for the conservation of the biodiversity of Jeju Island. Volunteers will engage in marine biodiversity conservation activities. They will also have the opportunity to experience the biodiversity of Jeju Island, and have discussions with local workers and youth to share ideas and experiences.

Accommodations: Volunteers will be housed together in nearby community center building. It is not necessary for participants to bring their own sleeping bag, mat, or other bedding.

Food: Food will be prepared by the volunteers.

Language: English will be used.
