WORK: The first work week will offer a unique backcountry tent camping experience to build a new trail in a remote region of the park. The second work week will include campground maintenance projects based out of a roadside cabin facility.

STUDY THEME: Environmental ¿ Wilderness / Park Management

LOCATION: Baxter Park is a unique and beautiful 209,501 acre wilderness preserve not far from the rugged and famous rocky coast of Maine, 2 hours north of Bangor.

TERMINAL: Bangor International Airport or bus to Medway, Maine. (Or train service only to Portland, ME).

LEISURE ACTIVITIES: Hiking, swimming, canoeing, optional guided whitewater raft trip (\$55 separate fee), see moose, bear, loons, and other wildlife. Meet and share memorable experiences with other people. Discussions will focus on wilderness with park staff and knowledgeable guests.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tent camping for four nights during the first work week. In dormitory style cabin with no electricity, including running water for hot showers during campground projects of second week. You¿ll live near the foot of beautiful Mt. Katahdin .

SPECIAL REMARKS: Must bring a backpack, sturdy hiking boots, work gloves and rain gear. Willingness to work hard, Ability to hike up 8 miles/6 kilometers. No smoking in Park facilities. A complete gear list will be sent with the information sheet.
